It will help you facilitate an easy transition to Meet Manager for our championship meets. And from what I have been told, it is very much a "user friendly" program. This is also a team manager program that you will be extremely happy to have for your team's personal organizational purposes. Each team will have a four-letter team code that will be used by them and them only. Please remember to renew your team registration before May 1st of this year to avoid the \$100.00 late registration fee. Instead of the usual \$75.00 renewal fee, you will be assessed \$175.00

I am aware of the trials and tribulations we encountered this past year because of the misleading advancement rules to the Junior Olympic Nationals. I brought this issue up during one of the general sessions to only realize that the advancement rules will not be changed. They will continue to use the 8th place time as the qualifying standard for advancement. Therefore, unless you have an exceptionally gifted athlete I would not rely on those standards and treat this as we have in the past. Only the top three athletes advance to the Junior Olympic Nationals.

This year we again have the honor of hosting five championship meets; the Subbantam Championships, PAC Championships, JO Championships, Region 14 Championships and the Multi Event Championships. Again as a group, we (the Youth Committee members),

are responsible for the operations of these five meets.
