- WHERE:Hornet Stadium, Sacramento State University<br/>Host of the 2007 NCAA Division I Outdoor Track & Field Championships
- **DIVISIONS:** This meet will be open to collegiate, club, and unattached athletes.
- **ENTRIES:** Submit online entries via website <u>www.runnercard.com</u>. Entries will open on Friday, May 1<sup>st</sup> at noon and close at noon on Wednesday, May 6<sup>th</sup>, when the website will be closed. No additions or changes will be accepted after this deadline. **Telephone, email, and faxed entries will NOT be accepted.**
- ENTRY FEE:Entry Fees for collegiate teams are \$250.00 per gender, or \$500.00 for<br/>combined teams. Unattached athlete Entry Fees are \$20.00 per individual<br/>athlete per event (example 2 events entered = \$40), and \$20.00 per relay team.<br/>Entry Fees must be paid prior to the start of competition. - **RULES:** NCAA rules will apply. The NO false start rule will be enforced. All running races are timed section finals. All field events are 3 attempt preliminaries with 8 advancing to a 3 attempt final. In the case where numbers are excessively large, we may allow only 4 attempts with no final.
- **FACILITIES:** Hornet Stadium is furnished with a 400 meter MONDO surface. The horizontal jumps and javelin approach are also made of MONDO. On all MONDO surfaces, the required spike length and type is <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> inch pyramid or xmas tree spikes. **NO needle spikes are permitted.** The throwing circles are of brushed concrete.
- **WARM-UP AREA:** Hornet Stadium and the Alex G. Spanos Sports Complex has a 400 meter MONDO warm-up track. **All general warm-ups must be conducted on the** warm-up track.
- **EVENT CHECK-IN:** All running event/relay teams must check-in with the clerk of the course 30 minutes prior to the event. Field event competitors will check-in at the respective event site at least 45 minutes prior to event.
- **TIMING:** Fully automatic timing with Finish Lynx.
- WEIGH INS: All implements must be checked in between 8:00am to 10:30pm in location TBA.
- **RESTROOMS:** The facilities are located on the back side of the east and west grandstands.
- LOCKER ROOMS: Locker rooms will NOT be available.
