The Advantages

- o Membership in an organization of people who care deeply about track and field and take responsibility for running meets safely and fairly
- Access to advanced officiating training
- o Liability insurance for all meets you work, whether USATF-sanctioned or not.
- o Authority to sign off on records

How to Become Certified

- o Step One: Join USA Track and Field (\$30/year), by going to www.pausatf.org, and clicking on "Join Now" [if you are already a member in another capacity—as a coach, for instance—skip this step]
- o Take an Introductory Clinic (\$35—includes USATF, NCAA and NFHS rule books—and certification). Register by going to www.pausatf.org, clicking on "Officials," then "Direct link."
