The USATF Coaching Education Developmental Coach Program is a four hour introduction to coaching intended for beginning coaches and volunteers at any level, from youth to collegiate. The Pacific Association program will be held in conjunction with the Willie Davenport Olympian Learn By Doing Clinic, and is ideal for beginning coaches and interested parents or volunteers to gain nationally recognized documentation while athletes are on the field with clinicians in the learn by doing clinic.

In designated classroom:

10:00-10:30am - introduction to philosophy and ethics of coaching

10:30am-12:00pm – growth and development considerations for youth athletes

1:00-1:45pm – biomotor development for young athletes

1:45-3:00pm – T&F practice design and structure

3:00-3:30pm – introduction to risk management and liability
