

In response to the concerns for safety of athlete', staff, and spectators in addition to potential exposure to liability, the Pacific Assoc. Board of Athletics voted at the 15 May, 2012 BOA meeting to create the position of Risk manager to be present at all meets managed directly by an association sport committee.

Title: Board of Athletics Risk Manager

Role:

Overview of event to promote safety of all in attendance and protect the liability of the Association

Coordinates with LOC regarding the facilities, to minimize hazard and incidents at the venue.

Review and analyze event facilities and procedures to identify potential safety hazards, as applicable to athletes and spectators in areas such as:

Athlete flow from registration and warm-up, through the conclusion of the event and return to spectator areas.

Spectator safety and security issues.

Specific event venues - meeting and conferring with event head officials to identify any potential safety problems.

Reporting findings and making recommendations to designated Board Executive Committee representative(s).
