



## Become a USATF CERTIFIED OFFICIAL

### The Advantages

- Membership in an organization of people who care deeply about track and field and take responsibility for running meets safely and fairly
- Access to advanced officiating training
- Liability insurance for all meets you work, whether USATF-sanctioned or not.
- Authority to sign off on records

### How to Become Certified

- Step One: Join USA Track and Field (\$30/year), by going to [www.pausatf.org](http://www.pausatf.org), and clicking on “Join Now” *[if you are already a member in another capacity—as a coach, for instance—skip this step]*
- Take an Introductory Clinic (\$35—includes USATF, NCAA and NFHS rule books—and certification). Register by going to [www.pausatf.org](http://www.pausatf.org), clicking on “Officials,” then “Direct link.”
