

# Proposed 2014 Training Clinics for Pacific Association Officials

The following is information about the proposed training clinics which will be given by the Pacific Association/USATF Officials Committee in 2014. Some subtle changes may be made, but this information is firm enough for you to start making plans.

This is NOT an opportunity to "Sign-Up" for clinics yet. In early December you will receive a Google.doc for sign ups.

- We expect a clinic at ARC (**American River College**)... **Saturday, January 11<sup>th</sup>**.
- We expect a clinic at **Serra High in San Mateo, Saturday, February 9<sup>th</sup>**.
  - **Satellite meets will be held in Chico (Saturday, January 25<sup>th</sup> Pleasant Valley H.S. Library), Santa Cruz (Saturday, February 8<sup>th</sup>, Santa Cruz High) and in Reno (Saturday, March 1<sup>st</sup> at a site to be determined).**
- **Rule Updates** will be included in each class which is offered. 2014 is not a year for new rules.
- We would expect that we would offer, at least, the following clinics...

## Introduction to Track & Field Officiating...ARC, Serra High, Chico, Reno, Santa Cruz

**Fundamental Classes** (a PREREQUISITE to advancement from the ASSOCIATION LEVEL to the NATIONAL LEVEL)...ARC, Serra High and some in Chico and/or Reno and/or Santa Cruz

*The class includes rules, paper work, procedures, how to "set-up" the venue and a hands on experience of running the event.*

- ① **Fundamentals of Horizontal Jumps and Throws** Officiating
- ② **Fundamentals of Vertical Jumps** Officiating
- ③ **Fundamentals of Track Event** Officiating (With half the time devoted to **Clerking** and the other half devoted to **Umpiring** and **Lap Counting**...for Umpiring/Lap Counting to be complete, mentored practice is required.

☺ *Note that we have separated Vertical Jumps for the Horizontal Jumps/Throws Clinic*

- ② Vertical jumps
- ③ Throws.

## Race Walk

- ① **Introduction to Race Walk Officiating** (both ARC, Serra and Reno)
- ② **Introduction to Race Walk Judging** (both ARC, Serra and Reno)

## LDR

- ① **Intro to LDR Officiating** (both ARC and Serra)
- ② **Fundamentals of LDR Referring**...both already certified and those who want to become certified...at Serra

Mental disabilities = Special Olympics; Para-Olympics = **Cathy Seller's** on-line instruction and on-line test with Sellers grading and advancing). **Note - the Pacific Association is in line to host several Para-Olympic meets in 2014.**
