for athletes 30 years and above

Facilities: College of San Mateo has a nine (9) lane Mondo surface including steeplechase and Jumping / Javelin runways. **Required spike is ¼ inch Christmas tree or pyramid compression.** All throwing rings are brushed concrete.

Javelin, Hammer, Weight & Superweight throws will be on the upper field above the stadium; Shot Put & Discus will be on the track infield.

Eligibility: All competitors must be registered USATF Athletes. USATF membership is available for \$29.95 online <http://www.pausatf.org/data/PAAppOnline.html>, or at the registration table the day of the meet.

Day of Meet Registration: \$40.00 first event, \$10.00 each subsequent event. Those who registered online adding add'l event(s) on meet day: \$10.00 per event. **Cash Only.**
Deadline is 11:00am for all events, no matter when they are run/contested. No Exceptions.

Entry Fees: Online Registration: \$20 for your first event, and \$5 for each subsequent event by 6:00pm, June 12. Online registration requires add'l \$3 USATF processing fee.

Awards: Gold/Silver/Bronze medals in 5yr age/gender groups (30-34, 35-39, 40-44, etc.) in each event. Collect at the awards table approximately 30 minutes after results are announced.

Athlete Check-In: All athletes must check in at registration table above the track 30min before competition to pick up bib numbers to compete, including a sticker that will list the events entered. This sticker will be checked when reporting for events.

Running Events: Athletes shall check-in with the Clerk before events. All running events will be run as finals with heats and lane assignments organized on the start line before each race. Listen for public address announcements telling when to report.

Field Events: Athletes shall check-in at the event site. Listen for announcements telling when to report.

Implement Certification: Will be from 7:45am to 1:00pm at the upper field shed located above the track. Athletes must bring their own implements.

Concessions: College of San Mateo will run a concession stand above the track for your convenience.

RUNNING EVENT Check In: Competitors must check-in at the clerk area 30 minutes before their race begins.

Clerking will be done at the start line. Competitors may be sub-divided to appropriate lanes & flights based on gender & age by the clerk.

In lane-races, an athlete who arrives late might get a lane, but shall not replace any athlete already assigned a lane.

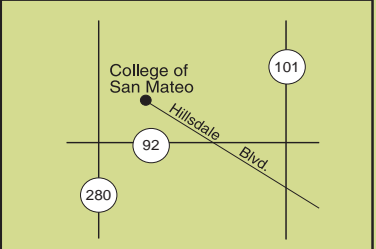
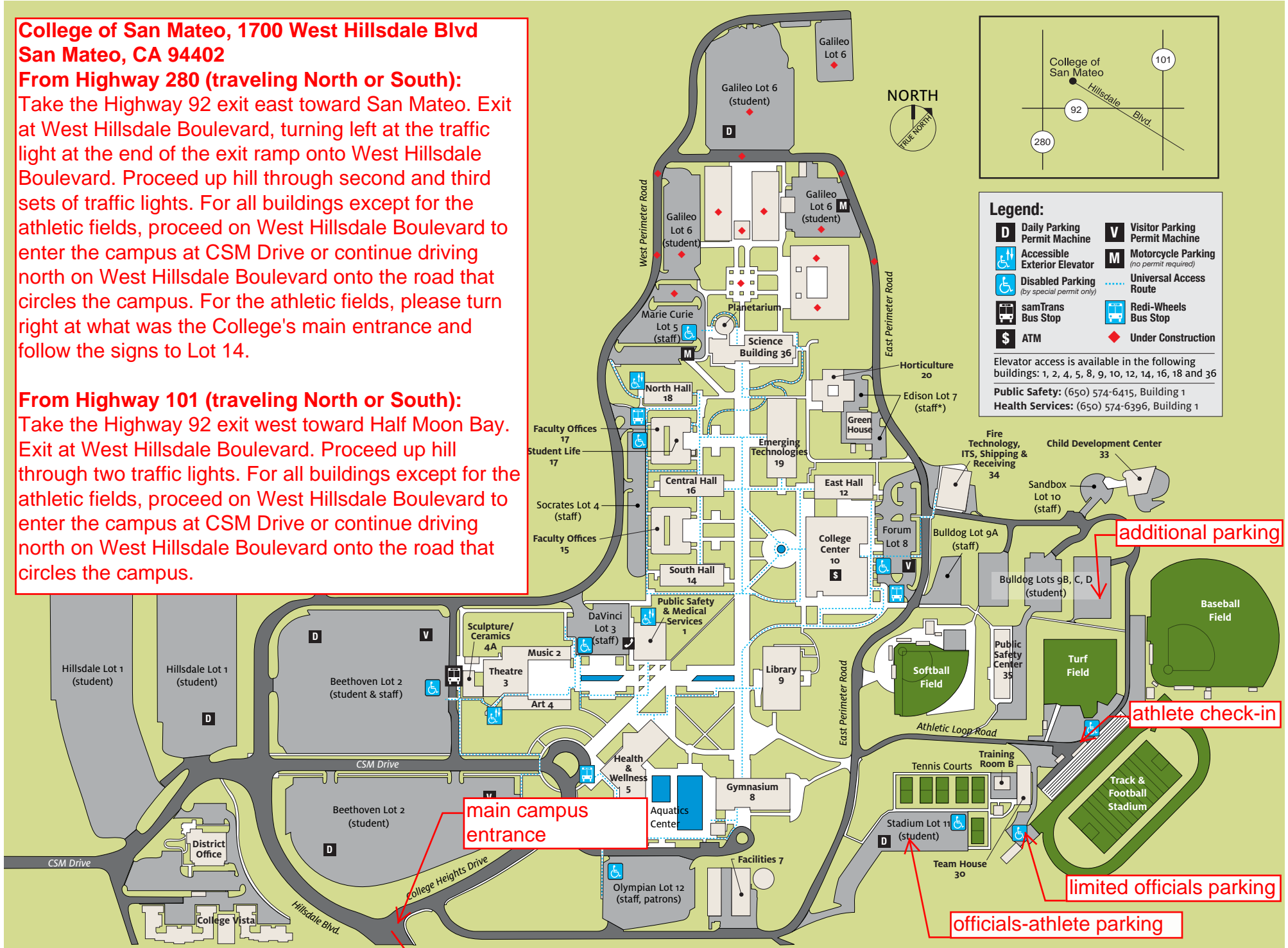

From Highway 280 (traveling North or South):

Take the Highway 92 exit east toward San Mateo. Exit at West Hillsdale Boulevard, turning left at the traffic light at the end of the exit ramp onto West Hillsdale Boulevard. Proceed up hill through second and third sets of traffic lights. For all buildings except for the athletic fields, proceed on West Hillsdale Boulevard to enter the campus at CSM Drive or continue driving north on West Hillsdale Boulevard onto the road that circles the campus. For the athletic fields, please turn right at what was the College's main entrance and follow the signs to Lot 14.

From Highway 101 (traveling North or South):

Take the Highway 92 exit west toward Half Moon Bay. Exit at West Hillsdale Boulevard. Proceed up hill through two traffic lights. For all buildings except for the athletic fields, proceed on West Hillsdale Boulevard to enter the campus at CSM Drive or continue driving north on West Hillsdale Boulevard onto the road that circles the campus.
