Below you will see the descriptions of the 2022 Training Schedule and a list of the Clinics. Those highlighted in vellow are confirmed and those highlighted in blue need to have a few details ironed out, but I wanted to get this out to you for inclusion on your calendars. Please keep in mind that with the everchanging COVID climate, any in-person class may be canceled or changed to Zoom.

To sign up for a clinic please respond to this email or send me a separate email. Sign up for as many or as few as you like. You will see on January 16 that you can sign up for three separate opportunities, the Rules Update and two of three for Horizontals, Throws, and Verticals.

If you plan to Officiate or Mentor at one, or more, of the All-Comer meets please contact the coordinator for the appropriate meet.

Instructors are needed. Please contact me if you wish to instruct at one of the clinics or Throws competitions.

**Introduction to Throws, Horizontals, and Verticals Clinics:** Will cover the basics of the events such as rules, measurement techniques, position duties and how to perform those duties up to and including the position of Flight Coordinator.

Intermediate/Advanced Clinics: Designed for Crew Chiefs, these classes will cover items such as pre-meet preparations, pre-event preparations, event duties, and post-event duties.

Apprentice Starter: For those who are interested in being Starters or are inexperienced Starters who want a refresher on the basics of Starting

**Championship Meets**: Although this clinic is being presented by two Master Starters, it is open to all. This clinic will discuss career goals and how to accomplish them. If you are interested in getting to Championship meets, High School to the Pros, this is for you.

**EDR:** Will cover the process of recording throws or jumps into an electronic data system such as FieldLynx. We need EDR folks. This specialty could provide a fast track to Championship meets. There will be two (2) in-person clinics with a maximum number of 12 attendees per clinic. Laptop computers will be provided for this training.

**Meet Bob Podkaminer**: While open to all, this is primarily an opportunity for Apprentice and Association Officials who may not have had the opportunity to meet Mr. Podkaminer. "Pod" is a Pacific Association Official, and there is not enough space on this page to begin to tell you of his accomplishments. **DO NOT MISS THIS OPPORTUNITY.**

Another good opportunity to hone your skills in the event of your choice prior to the start of the season.

**Throws at Golden State Throwers**: These two events will give you practical experience in Throws Competitions. Being contested are the Hammer and Weight throws. You will have the opportunity to focus on field inspection, looking over the implements, reviewing rules, giving athlete instructions, calling up athletes, measuring throws, and completing flight sheets. These are two of the only meets around where you will get to work the Weight Throw. Experienced Throws Officials will be needed as instructors/mentors.

**Cordova High School Events:** There will be a live **Throws only** competition at Cordova High School. If all goes according to plan there will be an Implement Inspection clinic and a Throws clinic in conjunction with that event. The EDR scheduled for that day is a separate clinic and will **not** be part of the throwing competition.

**Meet and Greet:** These are informal get togethers intended to introduce newer Officials to some of the more experienced Officials with whom you will be working. Much is learned by sitting around the table asking questions, or just listening, while noshing on pizza (or whatever) and drinking soda. There will be one in the Sacramento area, one in the Bay Area, and one on Zoom.
